The date of the next meeting is up for discussion as the group normally take a break in the Summer.Contact Geoff as above if you would like join us.


LUNCH & DINNER CLUB JACKY DURRANT

Russian Romanov Dynasty Carol Anderson

The August session of the history of the Russian Romanov Dynasty will be held at my home on Thursday,




17th August at 10:00. It will focus on from his first wife, and Peter, son of Alexis from his second wife. Ivan V was sickly and unable to take the reins of power and Peter was too young, thereby providing an opportunity for Sophia to live her dream of being regent to the boys and hopefully more thereafter. Her ultimate fall from power at the hands of Peter the Great concludes the second part of this session, where we will focus on his life and how he earned the title of Peter the Great, bringing Russia into a modern and politically strong country.

The September session of the history of the Russian Romanov Dynasty will be

held on Thursday, 14th September at 10:00. The 15-20 years that followed the death of Peter the

Great brought saw a number of supplicants anxious to take the crown. This included the short reign of Catherine, Peter's wife. Her death signed the start of a period of palace revolutions and Peter II, young son of Alexi whose drinking and debauchery led to an early death, hastened by a bout of smallpox, all before he married and produced an heir. This led to a period of Oligarchy and the crowning of Anna, daughter of Ivan V. The choice was unorthodox but otherwise allowed the continuation of the Romanov dynasty. And finally, into this chaotic period of "where will we find an appropriate successor" came the daughter of Peter the Great, Elizabeth, whose rule as Empress of Russia lasted 21 years.
